This issue has been raised with Highways and Broadlands and the PC has been advised that although it is recognised that the flooding issue needs to be addressed, nothing will be done about it anytime soon. Also clarification is also needed to know the condition of the swings and if there has been a report regarding maintenance. There are also gates, who owns the gates? Is it Council responsibility? If the lease can be terminated at any time by the Council, can the PC also have an option to terminate. Money for this project will be raised by grants and be self funding, there are no funds available in the precept. A protection order will be looked into regarding dogs.
